Defining CPD

Continuing professional development (CPD) is variously defined as the means by which professionals maintain, improve and broaden their knowledge and skills and develop the personal qualities required in their professional lives. CPD is the holistic commitment to structured skills enhancement and personal or professional competence.

CPD can also be defined as the conscious updating of professional knowledge and the improvement of professional competence throughout a person's working life. It is a commitment to being professional and keeping up to date.

Recognising and recording CPD

Currently the DVSA and the driver training industry are encouraging ADIs to start CPD. The recommendation is to take a minimum of seven hours (one day) of CPD each year. All those undertaking CPD should reflect and record the CPD that they undertake and forms on which to do this are available to MSA GB members on the MSA GB website.
